## **RESPECT AND OBEDIENCE TO THOSE IN AUTHORITY**

The Management, Staff and Student Office-bearers are in authority over the students. We consider it a very important part of the training for good citizenship that every student should obey and respect those who are in authority. Both inside and outside the school, the conduct of each student should reflect this attitude.

# SCHOOL RULES

## I. ATTENDANCE

All students are expected to be regular and punctual in their attendance at school, including during games and sports. In case of failure, the following points should be noted:

1. Normally children may be kept at home only for the reason of ill - health. Leave of absence from school for marriages or other functions must be applied for in advance.
2. When a student returns to school after half, one or two days of absence, the reason for absence must be recorded in the column 'Absence Record' provided in the Handbook, duly signed by the parent and acknowledged by the class teacher. If absent for more than two days, a letter of excuse of illness from the parent should be submitted to the class teacher along with a medical certificate. Vague terms of excuses will not be accepted.
3. Absence from school on the last day or on the first day of a term will be treated as a serious rule breaking. When returning to school, the student will not be allowed to attend classes until the Principal's permission is obtained.
4. It is mandatory for the student to present a full day's attendance on the day of test. In case of illness, it is strongly recommended that the student stays back from school.
5. The late - comer should report to the P.E. Dept before going to class. Permission to leave early should be obtained from the Principal. A letter of explanation from the parent should be submitted in both cases.
6. Students are forbidden to leave the school premises during school hours.

## II. SCHOOL FEES

School fees for the whole year need to be paid in four installments between the 5th & 20th of April, July, October & January. If there is a due, a fine of Rs. 100 will be added to the outstanding fee amount every quarter. Transport fee, if the school transportation facility is availed, should be paid in three installments in July, October and January. School collects both types of fees for full 12 months.

The school reserves the right to disallow a child with fee due in the class/ examinations and not to issue report cards, books and stationery, admit cards, certificates including TC etc.

School expects all students and parents to meet these expectations and respond accordingly.

### III. UNIFORM (REGULAR)

All students should wear the School uniform for all school functions and for attending classes. Each student should be equipped with a minimum of two sets of uniform. The Sports uniform is to be worn on every Wednesday.

**BOYS (I - X):** Blue shorts for boys till Std. Vi and pants for boys from Std Vii to X, with blue pin stripe shirt, school tie, white socks and black shoes.

**GIRLS (I - X):** Blue pinafore with blue pin stripe shirt, blue/black shorts, school tie, white socks and black shoes.

**Boys (XI & XII):** Blue pants and yellow shirts with blue pin stripes, plain blue tie, white socks & black shoes.

**Girls (XI & XII):** Blue pants and yellow shirts with blue pin stripes, white socks & black shoes.

### SPORTS UNIFORM (I - XII)

**Boys:** White shorts for boys till Std. VI and white pants for boys from Std VII to XII with house shirt, white socks and white canvas shoes.

**Girls:** White skirt, white shorts for girls till Std VI and white pants for girls from Std VII to XII with house shirt, white socks and white canvas shoes.

### COMMON REQUIREMENTS

1. **Shoes:** Boys' shoes are to be with laces. Girls' shoes should have straps. Students should wear white canvas shoes for P.T. Classes.
2. **Belt:** If worn, should be simple and black or brown in colour.
3. **Sweaters/Cardigans:** (wearing is optional) should be grey in colour.
4. **Identity Card:** Students are expected to wear their ID card everyday to school. In case the ID card is lost it shall be mandatory to get a new ID card on extra charges.

**N.B.** It is important that all items of uniform conform to the specifications laid down by the school in terms of design, colour, material etc. Further details are available at the School Office.

## **RESTRICTIONS APPLICABLE TO BOYS AND GIRLS**

1. **Hair:** Boys' hair should not be long enough to come over the shirt collar or over the ears. Fancy hair style is not allowed. Girls' hair should look well-groomed and modest. Hair should be plaited, if it is more than shoulder length. Ribbons, clips etc., if used, should be black in colour. No special decoration of hair is allowed.
2. **Finger nails** are neither to be painted nor allowed to grow long.
3. **Ornaments:** Rings, bangles, threads, studs (for boys only) and jewellery are not allowed.
4. **Wrist watches:** Pupils in std V and below should not wear watches. Musical watches and watches with games should not be worn.

## **IV. COMPOUND RULES**

### **LOST PROPERTY**

1. Any money or article of values found in the compound, should be handed over to the office without delay.
2. All personal properties should be marked with the owner's name. This will make it easier to restore lost properties to the rightful owner.
3. If any valuable item is lost, the same should be intimated to the class teacher/office at the earliest.

### **RESTRAINTS ON OUT-OF-CLASS ACTIVITIES**

1. Games before morning assembly and during the short break are not allowed.
2. Running, shouting and playing games in the classrooms, staircases or corridors are strictly forbidden.
3. School offices and staff rooms should not be disturbed by loud talking and group discussions by students near these rooms. Students, when passing by or waiting near office, should be quiet.
4. Leaves, flowers, fruits and branches are not to be plucked from any of the trees and plants on the campus.
5. The following are strictly forbidden:
  - I) Climbing on trees or roofs of the building or compound wall.
  - II) Throwing stones, sand or anything solid.
  - III) Playing with water or throwing water on others.

6. Books, magazines, comics etc., which are neither needed for class work, nor belonging to the school library should not be brought to school, except by permission of the class teacher.
7. No student shall remain in the school compound after 4.15 pm unless it is for an organized school activity.
8. Any damage to school property should be reported at once to the Principal by the students who caused it and by those who saw the incident.

## **V. STUDENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. Students should not indulge in any act of vulgarism, obscenities, bullying or using inappropriate languages.
2. Students should not involve themselves in any unfair means during tests/exams. If any student is found guilty, the school has the right to award zero in the respective subject and issue a warning letter. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal .
3. Students are strictly prohibited from riding/driving **two wheelers/four wheelers** as it is banned under the law.
4. Students are not allowed to bring /use **mobile phones** and unauthorized **gadgets** to the school.
5. If a student/students witness any kind of deviance by any other student from the prescribed code of conduct, the same has to be immediately reported to the Teachers/Vice Principal/Principal.

## **VI. LIBRARY**

1. Strict silence is to be maintained in the library,.
2. Students are permitted to take only a note book and pencil into the Library. Ink pens are not allowed.
3. A fine of Rs.1.00 per day will be charged for overdue books.
4. The cost of the library book lost or damaged will be recovered from the student.

## **VII. SCHOOL TRANSPORT**

1. Students who are in need of school transport facility shall inform the same to the Class Teacher and the correct pick up/drop point is to be clearly specified in the prescribed form.

2. If there is any change later in the given pick up/drop points, the same shall be informed to the Transport-in-charge, filling in the Student Indicative Data Change Form. No new pick up/drop points will be allotted other than the places prescribed in the "Transport Chart."
3. Transport Fee must be paid along with the last three term fees and late payment if any, will attract fine.
4. Grievances, if any regarding the transport facility, shall be informed to the Principal in writing.
5. Students, who cause damage to the seats or any other fixtures in the school bus, will have to pay the restitutionary charges towards the same.
6. Strict discipline must be maintained in the school bus. No student is allowed to shout or throw things out of the windows.
7. Every student must enter and leave the bus in orderly lines.
8. If any student is found not behaving well in the bus, he/she will not be allowed to use the school bus, thereafter.
9. Parents must not use the school bus nor should they "reserve" seats for the children.

## **PLEASE NOTE**

1. Transport fees are computed to cover the operational expenses of bus routes such as fuel, salaries, legal fees, charges to RTO, road tax, insurance, maintenance, etcetera. These costs do not reduce with a student in a route not boarding. When a student is enrolled into a transport route the annual cost to ACHS to keep that route running remains constant. We sincerely hope the parent understands the dynamics of bus fees. Bus service is an optional service for every ward, however, the fees for these services cannot be prorated to the number of days the service was used by the ward. The school understands that unforeseen circumstances may result in abrupt discontinuation of transport use by students and in such cases, applications for refund maybe submitted to the School Management Committee for review.
2. Each year the School Management Committee reviews feedback from parents and students regarding the pick and drop points. The Committee then directs a survey to determine the feasibility. Various factors are

considered including vehicle maneuverability and safety of such points for students and parents. The Committee also studies the financial feasibility. A minimum of 10 students for both pick up and drop and three drop routes are required to consider a new pick up or drop point addition.

## **VIII. MORNING ASSEMBLIES**

Morning Assembly is intended to be an opportunity for the school family to meet together for worship and commitment to the lord.

Students should

1. line up quietly and stand in attention.
2. maintain a reverent, respectful attitude, recognizing that this is time of worship.
3. realize that every speaker is entitled to courteous attention at all times.
4. participate in singing, reading and prayer.

## **IX. LUNCH**

All students should bring their lunch to school each day. Students are expected to have good manners and use appropriate voice level at lunch. Each student is responsible for his/her lunch area. Running and playing inside the classroom or corridors during lunch break is not allowed.

## **X. HOMEWORK**

Homework is intended to give students independent learning experience and responsibility. It is a training process to assist each student in becoming a serious student, capable of independent work and consistent good effort. Regular home work and assignments train students for good habit patterns. It is unacceptable for a student to fail to complete home work or to do sloppy work.

Assignment must be submitted on time. The only excuse for incomplete home work is the student's illness or an emergency. This should be explained in a written note from the parent. If a student fails to bring in home work, he should complete it by the following day. Parents will be notified if a student is not turning in his home work, completed and on time.

## **XI. EVALUATION & PROMOTION**

### **EVALUATION:**

The School follows the uniform System of Assessment and Evaluation suggested by the CBSE from Std. VI to X. This scheme for classes VI-VIII has been designed on Term Assessment basis with gradual increase in the learning assessment as the students move forward. This would prepare the students to cover the whole syllabus of the academic year and face the challenge of class X Board Examination, and would thus, ensure the quality of education. For KG & Std I to V the school follows the 3 - Block Test model spread across the entire academic year.

The school provides a fearless, tension free, more meaningful and encouraging learning ambiance, without compromising the seriousness in the academic matters and discipline. Since the uniform System of Assessment demands a congenial atmosphere, the learning and assessment are done through well designed activities in addition to Pen Paper Tests that suit the lessons in the syllabus.

## **PROMOTION**

For **Classes I to VIII** Promotion is based on the day to day work of the student throughout the year and also on the performance in all the subjects both in the Periodic Assessment and Term /Annual Examination with at least 'D' grade in each subject. The minimum attendance required to appear for Term/Annual Examination is 80%.

For **Classes IX & XI** Examinations shall be conducted internally by the School. Classes **X** and **XII** examination will be conducted at the end of the course by the Board in all the subjects, except General Studies, Work Experience and Physical and Health Education, which will be assessed by the School. In order to be declared as having passed the examination, a student shall obtain at least 'D' Grade in all the five subjects of external examinations. In case of subjects involving practical work, the student must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in practical separately in addition to 33% marks aggregate, in order to qualify in that subject.

## **XII. ADHERENCE TO POCSO ACT 2012 (PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL OFFENCE)**

The school is very keen to provide a safe, protective and conducive environment to all the students and ensures strict compliance to the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence (POCSO) Act, 2012, as per the CBSE directives.

The students/parents are informed that, if any child feels insecure, abused or sexually harassed, report immediately to the School's Internal Complaints



Committee, or to avail the reporting mechanism facility- the complaint box/ child helpline 1098.

## FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

1. The parents/local guardians are responsible for the student's conduct, supervision of studies at home and payments.
2. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school so that every student may derive maximum benefit from the educational process. Co-operation in certain specific areas listed below is the minimum expected.
3.
  - I. Please read the rules listed in the diary and ensure that your child conforms to those rules.
  - II. Check the diary and look into the:
    - a) homework assigned
    - b) absence and late coming record
    - c) notices and circulars
  - III. Please use the diary to communicate with the teacher.
4. A Report Book showing the progress of the student will be issued to the parents as notified in the School Calendar. **Weakness, if any, should be noted and steps for improvement must be taken without delay.** Tampering with the entries in the Report Book is a very serious offence and liable to stringent punishment.
5. Parents should not meet or speak to teachers or students during class hours. Parents who seek information or wish to make a complaint, should contact the Principal. Interviews with teachers may be arranged by the Principal, if necessary.
6. Parents are welcome to meet the Principal, without prior appointments, on

Wednesdays and Fridays from 1.00 p.m to 2.00p.m

#### **XIV. UNDERTAKING BY PARENT/GUARDIAN & STUDENTS**
